The Process

- 1. Prepare
- Online application, solo, and preliminary video audition (if applicable).
- Medical documents

2. Apply

Submit your application via our website, including:

- Headshot
- Personal Statement/s
- Current CV (Optional)
- Selection of your preferred preliminary audition location or submission of your preliminary audition video

3. Preliminary Audition

Choose in person or video submission:

- Attend a preliminary audition in the UK (London or Manchester)
 or
- Submit your preliminary video audition as part of your application

4. Final Audition

Invitation only. All finalists must attend an in person final audition.

What You Need to Apply

1. Headshot

Please provide a clear portrait headshot, ensuring hair is away from your face. The image does not need to be professional, and we do not require any additional audition images.

2. Personal Statement

You are required to submit a brief personal statement, as part of your application.

Please prepare a personal statement that includes responses to the following questions:

- Why do you aspire to be an ENBS student?
- What are your future aspirations in dance?
- What has been your dancing highlight to date?

How to Submit Your Personal Statement

Please submit your personal statement in one of the following ways, most accessible to you:

► Written personal statement, no longer than 500 words
This written personal statement needs to be submitted in your application form, so we recommend using a word document.

➤ Video personal statement, no longer than 4 minutes

Video personal statements must be uploaded to YouTube as an unlisted video. You will need to provide the link in your application form.

3. Medical Information

Due to the nature and intensity of vocational training, it's imperative we receive information regarding your physical health, to ensure you can safely succeed on our course.

All applicants are required to submit the following completed documents no later than Monday 29 December 2025.

- Certificate of Health to be completed by your regular doctor
- Previous Injury History to be completed by the applicant
- Non-Regular Doctor Letter in case you choose to go to your non-regular doctor. We cannot accept a Certificate of Health from someone who doesn't know the applicant.

Please include the following where applicable.

1. Training History

- Current ballet school/training institution
- Previous ballet training (schools, teachers, dates)
- Styles studied (e.g., classical, contemporary, character, jazz)
- Notable summer intensives or short courses (include dates)

2. Performance Experience

- Roles performed (soloist or ensemble)
- Productions/showcases
- · Choreographers worked with
- Performance venues

3. Exams & Qualifications

- Ballet exams passed (RAD, ISTD, Cecchetti, etc.)
- Brief academic achievements

4. Competitions & Awards (optional)

- Competitions entered (name, year, result)
- Scholarships or recognitions received

Preliminary Audition Format

- 90-minute ballet class (max. 30 dancers)
- 30 minutes of pointe work (female dancers)
- 30 minutes of technique (male dancers)
- 1-minute classical ballet solo

Please allow up to 5 hours for your audition.

How to Prepare

Prepare a classical solo no longer than 1 minute (choreographed or improvised). Submit a Spotify or YouTube link for your music within your application. The panel will assess musicality, movement quality, and expression.

Audition Panel

The panel includes Artistic Director Lynne Charles and members of the ENBS Artistic Team.

Results

Applicants will be notified of their preliminary audition results within 14 days. All decisions are final and at the discretion of the Artistic Team. Feedback is not provided.

Preliminary Audition Video

If you're unable to attend a preliminary audition, you can submit a video.

What's required:

Two separate videos which must include the following:

- Set ballet exercises
- Ballet solo
- Set Ballet Exercises Please follow the exact examples demonstrated in the YouTube videos. Link for videos and music below.

2. Solo

- The solo must be no longer than 1 minute
- It must be classical ballet
- It does not need to be an already choreographed solo / variation, unless you wish
- It can be choreographed by you (or anyone) or improvised
- Please use music of your choice

The audition panel is looking at how you move, your musicality and how you express yourself within the solo. Please upload each video to YouTube as an 'Unlisted Video'.

You then to include the YouTube links to each video within your application form.

Audition Format Guideline

Please note audition formats are subject to change.

- 90-minute ballet class (max. 30 dancers)
- 30 minutes of pointe work (female dancers)
- 30 minutes of technique (male dancers)
- Improvisation

Please note audition formats are subject to change, and some applicants may be asked to meet with members of our Physio Team.

Results

Audition results will be shared on **Friday 27 March 2026**. All decisions are final, and no feedback will be provided. Please note we reserve the right to make offers to successful applicants prior to this date if necessary.

All applicants will be considered using the same criteria.

Successful students will be selected based on talent and the potential skills required for a career in professional ballet and dance, as well as being able to successfully complete the course.

Audition Criteria

Our audition panel will be marking and assessing the following qualities:

- Lines
- Musicality
- Articulation
- Dynamics
- Movement
- Use of space
- Versatility
- Adequate physical, technical & artistic aptitude

Application Fee

- £45.00 per applicant, payable upon submission
- Applications without payment may not be processed
 Payment is due once the Application Form has been completed
 via our website.
