## The Guardianship Agreement

This document serves to record and confirm the details of the Student, their Parent, and Guardian. By signing this agreement, you commit to adhering to our Guardianship Policy. It must be completed, signed, and returned before the student arrives in the UK and ideally before CAS is issued.

### Part 1

Our Guardianship policy emphasises the main stipulations of the School's expectations: all international students under 18 whose parents reside abroad must have a Guardian in the UK. This is because international students may not be familiar with the UK's educational system and may have limited English proficiency – making communication and understanding difficult. Additionally, the Guardian will support the student with practical needs.

The choice of Guardian is the parent's responsibility, and the School holds no legal responsibility for any Guardianship arrangements. The Guardian's role includes acting with parental authority in emergencies, providing care if required during absences from School, attending meetings, being familiar with School rules and policies, being English-speaking, visiting and supporting students, and notifying the School of absences if the student is unable to do so. Guardians are requested to live close to the school to provide quick support when needed, such as for medical emergencies or appointments.
